



## Job Description – Camp Leader (Sr. Counselor) - \$16/hr.

Camp EDIFY is a general summer camp where we believe that God wants all children to be whole and healthy in every aspect of their being. We are currently hiring a **Camp Leader (Job #31722-2022-CL)** this summer to assist us with daily activities and supervision of daily and fun weekly outings.

### Roles & Responsibilities

- Under the leadership of the Camp Manager (Director), assist with the supervision of the day-to-day activities of the children. Work closely with the Camp Manager to create/develop programming
- Assist in the leadership of camp activities and follow the program outline.
- Participate in 'Morning Manna' by acting, singing gospel songs, scripture memorizing etc. with campers.
- Create a safe and structured environment for children to learn and to explore throughout the day.
- Assist children in developing skill in sports activities and refresh their knowledge in Math and English.
- Teach arts and crafts, and healthy eating.
- Work effectively within an integrated setting by meeting the needs of all campers.
- Deal effectively with Camp Manager, peers, participants and the public.
- Accompany children to various outings in the community & ensure that they are safe and always accounted for.
- Show children how to respect themselves, their peers and others in the community.
- Carry out all duties that provide quality customer service.
- Must be willing and able to participate in water activities and be in the water, swimming pool etc. during supervision of the campers
- Other duties as assigned by the Camp Manager.

### Requirements

- Between the ages of 15 and 30 at the beginning of the employment period  
Must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act for the duration of the employment
- Must have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.
- Must have a valid CPR Certificate and First Aid Certificate by the first day of camp
- Provide a satisfactory Criminal Reference Check and Vulnerable Sector Screening upon hire.
- Complete the Plan to Protect Course
- Must be able to work a flexible schedule (between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.)
- Previous experience working with children and youth in sport, recreational or community setting is an asset
- Demonstrated oral and written communication skills, organizational & time management skills

### Salary & Duration

This position is supported by the Government of Canada and will pay a wage of **\$16.00/hour** at 35 hours/week over 8 consecutive weeks starting in June 2022 (training dates to be discussed).
